FIRST TOURNAMENT.....

This is a reminder to register for the Clearwater Tournament to be held on March 19/20 at the Piedmont Park Marina. Your registration is due to Steve Rhea by March 16th to avoid the \$10.00 late charge. Prior to fishing a tournament, we require.....

1. Your membership dues (still only \$10.00).
2. Your 'signed' rules acknowledgement form (bottom of tournament rules sheet).
3. Your boat fee (still only \$40.00 per boat).

Even though we are fishing out of Piedmont Park Marina, it will be CLOSED. There will be no gas or services available, so make sure you gas up before you get there.

Clearwater has NO SIZE LIMIT, so any (Largemouth, Smallmouth or Kentucky) Bass may be kept and weighed in. And with the point system this year (1 point per fish), Clearwater should give us a jump start toward "Angler of the Year". It could be a very important tournament when September rolls around.

French Gerleman Tournament

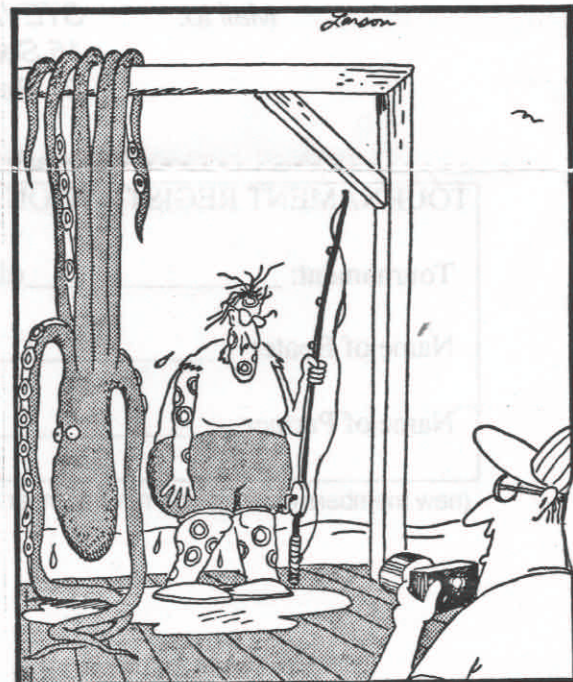
