Bob Ray, our Angler of the Year, was presented with a \$100.00 gift certificate, and Gene Reim, the Big Bass of the Year winner, was presented with a \$75.00 gift certificate. A TRAVELING TROPHY was presented to each winner (photos will be at the March tournament). They will be allowed to keep them until next year, when the trophies he Classic Dinner was held at Ryan's, and was attended by 26 Tmembers. Some wives and children also attended (at their own expense). Over \$1000.00 in attendance prizes, ranging from \$20.00 to over \$50,00, were awarded (to members). Prizes included two 48 quart coolers, two Diawa spincast reels, three Zebco Quantum rods, one Berkley Lighting Rod, four Plano tackle boxes, two Rubbermaid tackle boxes, five Rapala Shad Rap paks (5 Shad Raps in each), assorted lizard/worm paks with bags, and many others. The dinner was provided by the club, free of charge to anyone who participated in a 1995 tournamentwill be handed over to the next recipients. Each will also receive a commemorative sweatshirt (maybe they will wear them to the March tournament also).

During the discussion part of the dinner, the following points were raised.
