Next Tournament (continued)

We had two tournaments at Lake of the Ozarks last year. April was our regularly scheduled tournament, and the June tournament was moved to Lake of the Ozarks because of the unusually high water at Mark Twain Lake. Here are the specifics about those two tournaments.

In April we had our only <u>TIE</u> for first place. Two teams weighed in 7.42 pounds and tied for first place. The third place team weighed 7.40 pounds, which made for our closest finish ever. Fish were caught on Wiggle Warts, Plastic Worms.

<u>Defending champs (JUNE)</u> are Gary Eubanks and Jerry Oberbeck who's 6 fish set the "lake weight record" at 13.67 pounds in a tournament that produced nearly 100 pounds of fish. They caught their fish on Chartreuse Pumpkinseed lizards in shallow water.

Lake Record is 7.40 pounds, by Gene Reim and a white double willow leaf spinnerbait, in April of 1995. Unfortunately, this ALL TIME CLUB RECORD BIG BASS was caught near the Rod & Reel dock (last year we fished out of the Blue Dolphin Resort). This year we are fishing out of Rod & Reel so their dock will be in the no fishing area. Gene says that's OK because he released the fish over at the Blue Dolphin, and he plans to fish over there. (Gene/Ted: I'm sure you won't have any company at the Blue Dolphin dock)
