- There will only be one Big Bass award for Clearwater. The money for the second day Big Bass pool will help fund the B-B-Q's.
- 10) There were some minor changes made to the Points Sheet and the Tournament Rules. These will be distributed with the next newsletter. Please read them carefully because by joining the club in 1998, you are acknowledging that you have read, understand, and will abide by, those rules.
