June 24-25 at Orleans Trails Marina

Time to head south again. Stockton Lake and its 25,000 acres and almost 300 miles of undeveloped shoreline are home to Largemouth, Smallmouth, and Kentucky Bass.

Last year we had 28 boats at Stockton. Terry Bost and Randy Simonitch won Stockton Lake 1999 Hawg Hawler Tournament with 9 fish weighing in at 13.81 lbs. Aaron Mueller (Sat-4.18 lbs) and Rich Gaugh (Sun 5.22 lbs - Lake Record), caught the Big Bass last year.

Directions

I-44 S to Springfield. Take Hwy 13 N from Springfield to Hwy 32 W. Follow 32W into the town of Stockton to the 4-way Stop. Go L at the 4-way Stop, headed S on Hwy 39. Go 1 mile S on Hwy 39 to RB Road. Go L on RB Road and proceed 1/8 mile to Blake Street (look for the Car Wash). Take a R on Blake St. and go 1 mile to a "T" in the road. Go R at the "T" and go approximately 200 feet to the top of hill, then proceed left into the Orleans Trails complex.
