Last Tournament of 2000 -Lake of the Ozarks

October 7-8 at Irish Hills

The Hawg Hawler season will finish up with our traditional fall Lake of the Ozarks tournament. Like our spring tournament, we will be on the Niangua Arm of the Lake, fishing out of Irish Hills Resort. Note that 12" will be the minimum length limit for Spotted Bass, the Largemouth minimum will be 15" as usual.

Last year's October Ozarks tournament was won by Kelly Nolie and Joanie Dieckhaus with an 8 fish bag totaling 17.34 lbs on black buzz-baits.

Directions

From Camdenton, take Hwy 5 North 6 miles to a left at Lake Road 5-78 (just PAST the Conoco station). Follow the signs to Irish Hills. Please note that Irish Hills can only provide launching for those staying at the resort. Gale Access is just a few miles down the Niangua for those looking for a public ramp nearby.


