


BRIAN ROBINSON BIG BASS OF THE YEAR



Brian finished in 12th place. His Big Bass of the Year was caught May 19th at Pomme de Terre and weighed 5.58 lbs. Brian has been a club member since 1994 and has won Angler of the Year twice (1996, 1998), He won both Angler of the Year and Big Bass of the Year in 1996. Brian's Big Bass in 1996 is the third largest bass weighed in club history. Big Bass this year is the third smallest ever weighed.

TERRY STANEK ANGLER OF THE YEAR



Terry finished in first place weighing a total of 34 fish, placing five times and taking Big Bass twice for a total of 119 points. Terry is the clubs first three time Angler of the Year (1990, 1997, 2002). He has finished in the top ten 14 times over the I5 year club history. Terry is one of the founding members and has been an officer five times. He won both Angler of the Year and Big Bass for the year in 1997 with the 2nd largest bass ever weighed at 7.20 lbs.
