Good job guys, hope to see you guys fishing together in the club more. They took home \$320 for first place. Nice work guys.

Second place was Rob Cook and Bob Ray. Saturday wasn't as easy on these guys. They had 5 | Big Bass - Saturday fish for 6.86lbs. But Sunday was a different day for these two, they had double limits and a weight of 13.09lbs, for a total weight of 19.95 lbs. They took home \$228 for second place. Good job guys.
