Larry weighed in four nice bass and Scotty was the only angler to bring in a two day limit moving him into first place in the points standings. They caught their fish using Omega buzzbaits and wiggle warts. First place payout was \$206.

They brought eight bass to the scale for a total weight of 19.54 pounds. Second place payout was \$158.

New Hawg Hawlers members Larry and Joanne Chandler took third place with a total weight of 17.01 pounds. They were throwing ten inch red worms. Larry weighed in six nice fish with Joanne bringing in their kicker fish on Saturday weighing 5.79 pounds and taking big bass for the weekend. Third place payout was \$112. I sincerely apologize for not getting a picture of the third place team. I'm not sure how that happened but I suspect it might have something to do with "old age syndrome".

We all hate to see a fellow Hawg Hawler experience boat problems. Unfortunately, Bryan Slaughter and Andy Shands ran into some bad luck pre-fishing when Bryan's engine blew.
