On day one they brought an astounding 21.43 pounds to the scales to give them a very comfortable lead. On Sunday they added another 9.43 pounds to their total to secure the win. Their total weight was less than 1 pound under the lake heavy stringer record of 31.72 pounds set in June 2007. Mike & Jason won Mark Twain Lake last year in 2015. Tournament Big Bass Shawn Tiemann



Shawn Tiemann landed a 5.03 hog on Sunday to take big bass of the tournament. The fish was caught on a Strike King 5XD in Blue Gizzard Shad Color on a main lake point in about 12' of water. Shawn caught a big walleye on the same point the day before, so he was worried he hooked the same fish. Once they saw that it was a bass, Shawn and his dad started freaking out because she was barely hooked. Once it got close to the boat, his dad lunged half way out of the boat with the net making sure she didn't make another run. Once the lunker was in the boat both of their jaws dropped however it was quickly followed up with big high fives and fist bumps once she was safe in the live well. The fish won Shawn the Big Bass payout of the day of \$81 and an additional \$125 in side pot winnings.

Big Bass Saturday Rich Harper



Rich Harper's only keeper of the day on Saturday was a 4.61 pound largemouth that took big bass of the day. She was caught on a Strike King 6XD in Rootbeer color bouncing off of rocks in 12' of water. The fish was landed right next to the 107 bridge about 30 minutes before weigh-in. Big bass payout for the day was \$81.

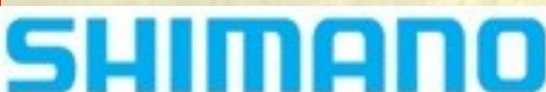

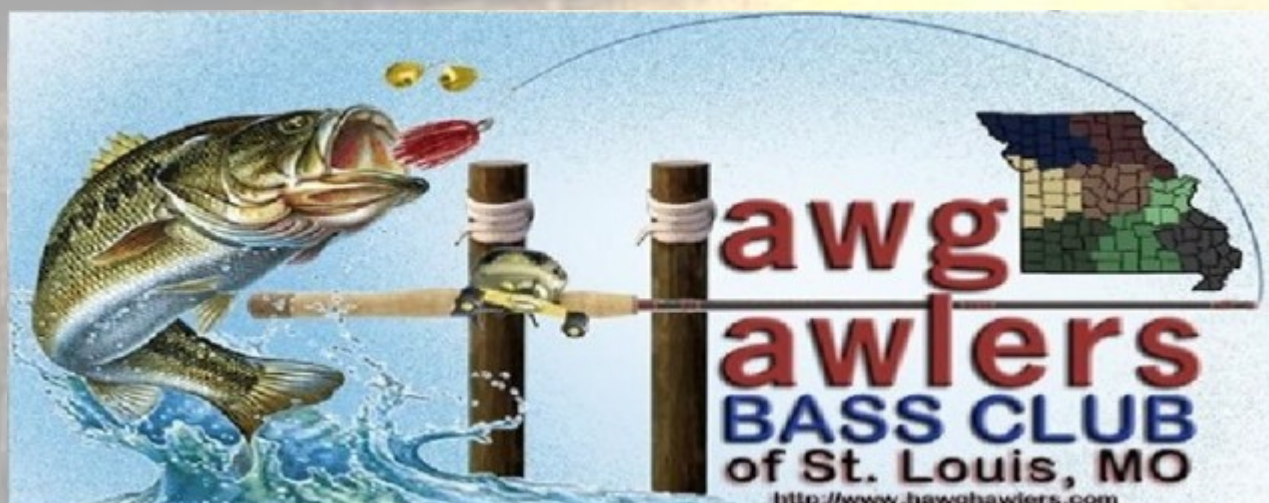
