No single angler caught more than 2 keepers per day. In fact, Jason & Rich Shaw were the only ones to bring 4 keepers to the scales in a single day as a team. Only 45 total bass were brought to the scales over the 2 day tournament. Who would have thought that the last freezing Lake of the Ozarks tournament with low 40 degree water would have brought nearly 3 times the fish to the scales!

At least we had a great event on Saturday evening at the Pavilion behind Sportsman's. Josh Harper slaved away at the BBQ pit cooking hamburgers and hotdogs for all to enjoy. We had a bracket style pitching contest that was a lot of fun and someone even broke out a cornhole game. Thank you to all who showed up, chipped in and those who brought side dishes. 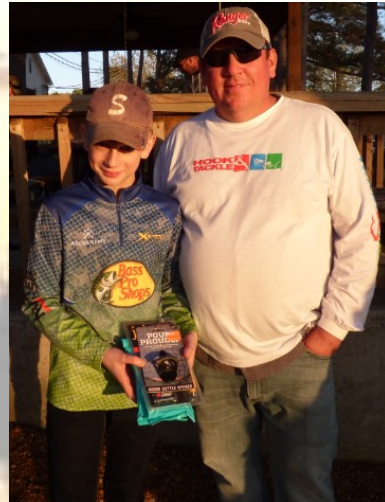

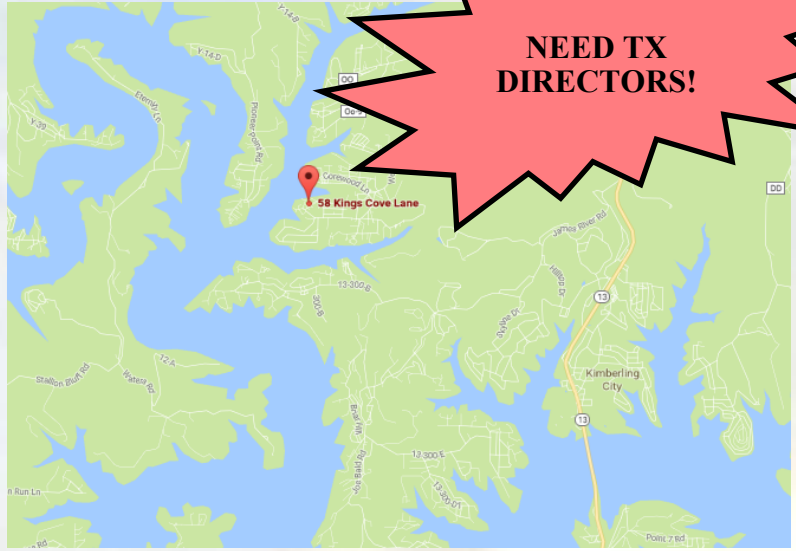
