## Lake News

**Norfolk** saw 21 boats for the first ever tournament on this lake. From what I heard from locals, the lake was very low for this time of the year (4-5 feet below normal) and the water temperature had dropped nearly 10 degrees in just a few days. The fishing seemed tough for most with fish seeming to be very scattered across the lake. Pinning down a particular pattern was very difficult and even finding a large number of 12" spotted bass proved difficult. A very long fog delay on Sunday was hard to sit through but I commend all the members for their patience. We take member safety very seriously and do not want to launch in these types of dangerous conditions. The fog was so thick that you couldn't see 20 feet in front of the boat when you got on the main lake.




