# IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS!!!!

Everyone who is currently a member of the Hawg Hawlers Bass Club received a copy of the club's tournament rules, in the March newsletter. It is the responsibility of each and every angler to be in compliance with these rules. It would be very unfortunate, not to mention most embarrassing, to be forced to forfeit a tournament weight, and/or prizes. Beginning with the May 1991 tournament at Mark Twain, the following will be in effect.....

During the tournament, the tournament director has complete authority. If a situation arises, the tournament director will determine the best course of action, to be taken, for that tournament. If necessary the rules committee will be notified.

A rules committee has been established, consisting of the four tournament directors. It will be presided over by the club vice-president (in a non-voting capacity). This committee will write, update, interpret and clarify the club tournament rules. Any time clarification is needed, the rules committee will meet to determine if any permanent rule change is in order. It is their responsibility to keep the club tournament rules as current, concise and understandable as possible.

PLEASE familiarize yourselves with the rules, and comply with them at all times to prevent any unfortunate situation from occurring.
