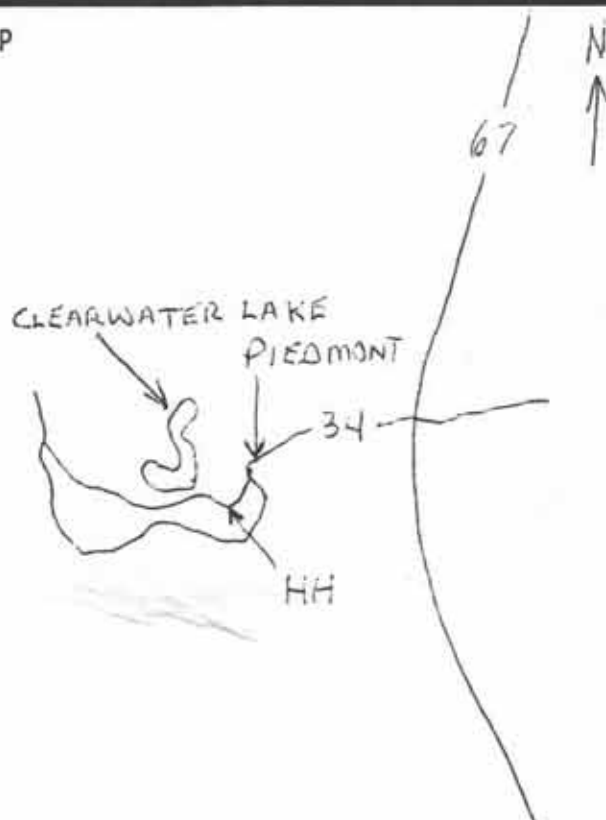

REGISTRATION

Tournament fee is \$40.00 per boat (includes big bass pool).

All registration must be RECEIVED by Wed prior to tournament.

TOURNAMENT

All participants must be current club members, in good standing.

All Hawg Hawlers, state, local and lake rules must be adhered to.

Pre-tournament meeting will be held for livewell/boat/time checks.

Only Largemouth, Smallmouth and Kentucky (spotted) Bass are allowed.

All fishing must be from a boat. Only 1 rod per angler at one time.

No trolling or culling. Only artificial lures may be used.

Penalties for short/dead fish or rule infractions will be enforced.

No fishing in the "No wake zone", of the take off/weigh in area.

All fish must be segregated by team members (in boat and at weigh in).

The club recommends all fish be released, immediately after weigh in.

Except for the October Classic, all tournaments will be "buddy" type

(boat partners weights added together to determine tourney winners)
