This month we returned to Truman Lake for some summer fishing. There were 11 boats participating in this tournament which means 4 places could be paid. After the Saturday's weigh-in it was still anyone's tournament to win, 1st place was still within any angler's reach with a couple of nice fish Sunday. There was a total of 15 fish caught in two days, totaling over 38 lbs. After totaling Sunday's fish the weigh-in committee was stunned to see that between 1st and 4th place there was a .24 lbs difference. So we decided to double check the figures to make sure they were correct. 1st place went to Mark Henry and Dan Price with a total weight of 7.59 lbs. 2nd place went to Ray Burns and Dave Sewel, with a big bass weighing 4.79 lbs, totaling 7.51 lbs. Third place went to Terry Stanek and Bob Treadway with a total weight of 7.47 lbs. And Fred Reece and Tom Creamer had 7.35 lbs. for 4th place.

A special thanks goes out to Dan Durbin and Tony Meyers for handling the tournament so well even in tough weather conditions.

The October tournament will be held at Mark Twain Lake this year as stated in the June newsletter. This tournament is going to be a draw tournament. Nobody will know who their partner is until the day of the tournament, even though you will still fish with the person you register with.

This event is also free as long as you have fished a previous tournament, if not you will be charged the regular tournament fee. We will be having the bar-b-que dinner at the Windmill Resort. We have obtained a discounted price of \$3 per person to camp on their lots. Further information about location will follow in the next newsletter. The tournament will be held on Oct 10 and 11. Entry must be received no later than Sept 23. Anyone signing up after this date will be subject to the regular entry fee.
