### LAST Tournament.....

The lake level at Truman was high, to say the least. At 735 feet, or 29 feet over normal pool, "high" might not be the best way to describe it. The **TOP** of the launch ramp, and the parking lot, at the State Park Marina, was under 9 feet of water. The most descriptive account of the water level was that at normal pool, Truman has about 56,000 acre/feet of water. On our tournament weekend the lake had about 160,000 acre/feet, or nearly 3 times normal. This made for some rather difficult fishing conditions. It was very difficult to find shoreline that wasn't in the foliage of trees. Let's throw in some severe thunderstorms, and heavy rain on Saturday to make it even worse. But someone always finds fish. This time it was Terry and Linda Bost, with some help from Shilo, their (Bass Pointer) dog.

**First Place** was won by Terry & Linda Bost with 3 fish weighing 6.82 lbs. They won \$ 132.00 for first place. They caught their 3 keepers shallow, up on the banks. Please note that this win puts Terry in First Place in the Angler of the Year competition.

**Second Place** was worth \$ 96.00 to Dan & Ken Price. Dan's 2 fish weighed in at 4.38 lbs. One of those fish was 2.61 lbs, and big enough for the Heavy Hawg (Big Bass) award, and another \$ 60.00. Their total take was \$ 156.00.

**Third Place** went to Gene & Ted Reim. Gene caught his 2.59 lb Bass real shallow. Gene wanted everyone to know that his fish was only .02 lbs (or one split shot) away from the Big Bass.

**Fourth Place** and \$ 36.00 went to Dave Sona and Gary Eubanks for Dave's 2.27 lb fish.

Two points (each), and major league thanks go to Tom Creamer and Fred Reece for overcoming some mechanical difficulties and doing a fine job running the Truman Tournament.


### NEXT Tournament..... Mark Twain
