Clearwater First Tournament for 2000

One Day Tournament on March 25

Our first tournament of the year will be at Clearwater Lake again this year, located near Piedmont, MO. Keep your fingers crossed for good weather, and bring your Ziploc bags (gallon size this year?)! Hope to see you there.

Directions

To get to Clearwater, take 55 South to 67 South, stay on 67 South to Hwy 34, take 34 West to Piedmont, go through Piedmont and take a Right on HH, that will take you to the lake.

Launch at Piedmont Park ramp (don't go across the dam). The tournament is out of <u>Piedmont Park Marina</u>, which will be to your right by water as you leave the ramp. Don't wait around at the ramp for the tournament like some folks did last year...it will be a long wait.

What's New For 2000

As a result of the member survey at the November Banquet, here is a summary of changes for this year.

- Point System. Creel points goes to two (2) points per fish (was 1).
- 50/50 Drawing. We will have 50/50 drawing at each tournament this year after Saturdays weighin. Get tickets from the club officers Saturday AM before the pre-tournament meeting.
- Winners Plaques. In addition to the normal cash purse, plaques will be given to both members of the 1st place team for the weekend, as well as to the angler that catches the heaviest Big Bass of the weekend.

Tom's 1999 points total of 79 was the culmination of a good, consistent season, allowing him to edge out Gene Reim, who finished second in the club points standings with 75. Congratulations on a great year Tom!

While Gene Reim may have ended up in second in points, he held on to first place with his 6.39lb bass from the spring Lake of the Ozarks tournament. Club President Gary Eubanks presented the Big Bass Trophy and G-Loomis rod to Gene. Great job Gene!

TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS

Tournament Directors are needed for all 2000 tournaments. Pretty easy piece of work for 2 points (maximum of 4 tournament director points per angler, per year). All you have to do is be available 30 minutes before takeoff each day, participate in livewell checks and hand out boat numbers. Get your picks for T Director in early, just fill in the section at the bottom of the tournament entry form.

These were our goals when we formed the HAWG HAWLERS Bass Club in 1988, with only 8 members. In 1999 we had 118 members. We must be doing something right.

The direction of the club has expanded to include a strong emphasis on family fishing. Many of our regular teams consist of husband/wife as well as father and son or daughter.

Our organization has 5 officers (Pres, Vice-Pres, Sec, Treas, and a Tournament Chairman). Their responsibilities include organizing, scheduling, and obtaining proper authorization for tournaments, allocating club funds, and publicizing information to the club members.

The Club conducts eight or nine tournaments during the year, beginning in March and running through October. They are formatted as "BUDDY" tournaments, with each boat consisting of a team of two-persons maximum. All tournaments are held on Missouri Lakes. Our tournament fishing times are generally 6 hours on Saturday morning or evening and 6 hours on Sunday morning (allowing for two weigh-ins). Our summer tournaments are usually Saturday and Sunday mornings, to escape the summer heat. Some members take golf clubs and get in a round of golf in the afternoon. We usually have two, club funded, Bar-B-Ques that coincide with tournaments.

Membership in the club is \$15.00 annually, per angler. The tournament entry fee is \$50.00, per boat, (which includes \$5.00/ boat big bass pool). Participants are competing for cash awards (approximately 90% tournament payback, with 10% going toward mailing expenses, insurance, and the "Awards Banquet"). Attendance prizes are awarded at each tournament (when there is no BBQ).

At the end of the year (October) we have an Awards Banquet. This where we present our BIG BASS and ANGLER OF THE YEAR traveling trophies. Dinner is Free to club members who have fished 2 tournaments for the current year. Any money left in the treasury,

and not allocated for some other purpose, is used for attendance prizes for all qualifying club members who attend. We also have a number of Corporate Sponsors who supply us with some very nice attendance prizes. Everyone qualifying for the "free" dinner gets an attendance prize.

If you think the HAWG HAWLERS Bass Club, an organization of sportsmen and women sharing a common interest, and providing a different kind of club fishing, is the thing for you, simply review the Tournament Rules attached, complete the Membership Information slip (don't forget to SIGN IT), and detach and return it along with your membership fee to Donnie Eubanks at the address on the form.

- Angler and Big Bass of the Year Trophies. In addition to the traveling trophies for these two accomplishments, take home trophies for the anglers to keep will also be provided.
- Big Bass Pins. In addition to the cash purse (and Big Bass of the weekend Plaque), Hatpins will be given to the Big Bass winner of each day of all tournaments.
- Banquet Date Changed. The end of year Banquet Dinner has been moved to an earlier date, October 28.
- Weigh-in Change. We will be using perforated bags at weigh-in to hopefully speed up the process.
- Schedule Change. Table Rock removed and Mark Twain added.
- Spotted Bass. Minimum length for Spotted Bass will be 12" for both Lake of the Ozarks tournaments, and for Bull Shoals.
