Directions

Take I-70 to highway 61 (at Wentzville), take 61 north. After you pass Bowling Green you will come to highway 54, take 54 west (left). Watch your speed through Curryville, it's a speedtrap. At the "Y" where 54 turns left, continue straight on 154 west. 154 will dead end into 19. Turn north (right) and go where 154 turns west (left) again (at the Junction Inn). Take 154 west through Perry, watch for the Robert Allen Access sign on the right. If you get to Highway 107, you went too far (go back).



WANT LESS EXPENSIVE GAS FOR YOUR BOAT?

The Missouri Department of Revenue will refund Motor Fuel Taxes for marine use. You need to save gas receipts and turn them in with the proper forms, but it's worth a refund of \$.17 per gallon. Depending on how much you fish during a year, that can add up to worthwhile savings.
