Wappapello next Tournament

August 25-26 at Barretts Marina

Barretts Resort is located across the cove from the Redman Creek Ramp. Please note - anyone not staying at Barretts will need to launch across the cove at Redman Creek.

Directions

55 south to 67 south to Greenville. Left on highway "D", go across Wappapello dam and watch for signs for Redman Creek Ramp. To get to Barretts Resort, continue 1 1/2 miles past the dam, go Right on "RA", and follow the signs to Barretts.

FISH HANDLING - BE KIND TO YOUR BASS

With the warm summer water temps, stress on caught and released fish is at it highest levels of the year. Here's a few tips to help your catch survive the journey to weigh-in and release.

- Fill livewells early (when surface water is coolest), close the system, and keep aerator running continuously.
- Cool your livewell with frozen 2 liter or gallon bottles of water.
- Use Catch & Release chemicals in your livewell (available at tackle stores).
- Cut the line and leave the hook in if the fish is hooked deep.
- Minimize handling. Get your fish into the livewell quickly, with minimal handling. When taking pictures, prepare in advance - wet your hands and remove the fish from the water just long enough to get the photo.
