2003 Clearwater Results

2003 saw the Hawg Hawler return to Clearwater Lake, and Clearwater welcomed us back with open arms and biting fish. Prior to the "T" there were many comments regarding ice-breaker boats, ice covered ramps, hard frozen water, and "what happens if...". Well, these comments were put to rest with a beautiful day that yielded a record catch for a single day. We had a total of 305 fish weighed in by the 36 boats, for an average of 8.5 fish per boat. The overall quantity record is 369 fish but that was for TWO DAYS (Wappapello – 2002).

Our Memorial Tournament honored some Hawg Hawler members who are no longer with us. A moment of silence was held to remember their friendships and contributions to the club.

Last year at LOZ in March 45 boats weighed in 15 fish for an average of .3 fish per boat. What a difference a year can make.
