Pomme De Terre – July 19/20, 2003

Weigh-in wasn't much to brag about on Saturday with only 36 fish weighed in. Pam Wakim & Frank Stanek brought in 5 fish to take the first day lead by a nice 2 lb margin. Ken McNeil and (new member) Cheryl Koza, weighed in 2 fish for a solid 2nd place. Cheryl's 3.46lb fish was the Big Bass for the day, and, as it turned out, for the whole weekend. Ed Knoll's 3.16 lber was a respectable "honorable mention" for Big Bass.

Mark Boyette, who was fishing in only his third Hawg Hawler tournament, weighed in his second Sunday/Pomme Big Bass. In May he had a 3+lber for a Sunday BB win. This time he had a 2.40lber that took the honors.
