Even with their .25lb (dead fish) penalty, they weighed in an impressive 9.69lbs (7 fish). There were no big ones, but they had enough weight to take home the "big" check (that Teddy wrote). Second place was won by, new members, Joe Gedville and Jeff Frailey with 8.50lbs (4 fish). Jeff's 4.31lb kicker on Sunday, took BB of the w/e honors and the 50/50 side pot of \$145.00. Terry Stanek and Bob Treadway took 3rd place with 3 fish that weighed 5.97lb. Dave McGarity took BB on Saturday with

Depending if the old scale can be repaired, we may keep it as a back-up, sell it, or trash it. The officers have also devised a "back-up plan" if we ever have a scale malfunction in the future.
