Lake of the Ozarks – October 3-4, 2009

Time: Sat: 7:00 AM – 3:00 PM Sun: 7:00 AM – 1:00 PM

Lake Conditions: Clear to slightly stained

Lake Level: 658

Water Temp: 64-69

Air Temp: Both Saturday and Sunday started out around 49 and ended up around 65

Weather: Saturday – partly cloudy / Sunday takeoff was delayed an hour due to thick fog until the sun finally came through

Winds: Saturday very windy, 25-30 mph / Sunday 5-10 mph

17 boats turned out at Lake of the Ozarks. A total of 46 fish were brought to the scales. One angler, Bryan Walker, brought in a 5 fish limit on Saturday.

### Tournament Results



**MICHAEL AND MICHAEL PARMENTIER JR. TAKE THE WIN WITH 7 FISH WEIGHING 13.39 LBS.** They reported catching their fish on Brush Hogs, Wave Worms and Jerkbait. They took home \$176.00 for first place. Great job guys!!



Second place was Terry Stanek and Lori Luzynski. They had a total of 8 fish weighing 9.87 lbs. They reported catching their fish on Crankbaits and Rogues. They took home \$140.00.



Third place was Bryan Walker and Russ Grobe. They had a total of 9 fish weighing 9.23 lbs. They reported catching their fish on Crankbaits and Swim Baits. They took home \$106.00.

Fourth place was Pam Wakim and Bob Treadway. They had a total of 5 fish weighing 7.91 lbs. They reported catching their fish on Strike King Crankbaits and Senkos. They took home \$78.00.

Apr. 25-26 was at Table Rock. 12 boats brought in 47 fish. Jeff and Amy Schwent took 1<sup>st</sup> place with 10 fish weighing 22.49 lbs.

May 16-17 was at Pomme de Terre. 17 boats brought in 66 fish. Tom O'Connor and Warren Lichius took 1<sup>st</sup> place with 7 fish weighing 12.25 lbs.

June 6-7 was at Mark Twain. 18 boats brought in 38 fish. Here comes Greg and Andy again to take 1<sup>st</sup> place with 13 fish weighing 29.09 lbs. (Note: This puts them in #8 for All Time Heavy Stringers Top Ten)

June 27-28 was at Truman. 9 boats brought in 25 fish. Again Greg and Andy take 1<sup>st</sup> place with 6 fish weighing 12.13 lbs. (This is getting old!! LOL)

July 18-19 was at Wappapello. 8 boats brought in 52 fish. The boys are here again: Greg and Andy take 1<sup>st</sup> place with 15 fish weighing 14.31 lbs.

Aug. 15-16 was at Pomme de Terre. 16 boats brought in 64 fish. Oh no – new winners!! Mike Parmentier and Larry Rutledge beat the Shands (LOL). I meant to say they took 1<sup>st</sup> place with 7 fish weighing 9.53 lbs.
