

## What's New For 2012

Your 2012 officers have been busy setting up a fun and interesting schedule for the 2012 fishing season. New officers are: President Greg Shands, Vice President Mike Jankowski, Treasurer Dan Durbin, Secretary Pam Wakim and tournament chairmen Chris Himstedt & Bryan Slaughter.

They have come up with a few new ideas and are repeating some of the fun events everyone enjoyed last year. One new idea they think you'll like is fishing three sessions at the spring Pomme de Terre tournament. We will be fishing 6:00am to 11:00am Saturday morning followed by a weigh in and going out again from 3:30am to 8:30pm for the evening bite and another weigh in. Sunday tournament hours are 6:30am to 11:30 am with the third and final weigh in. Points and payout will be the same as a regular tournament so your totals for the weekend will determine place, points and payout.

We are going to "test drive" a Friday night optional tournament. The first one will be at the spring Lake of the Ozarks tournament. It's a big bass bash from 3:00pm to 6:00pm, \$10 per boat with 100% payout.

New to the schedule: Rend Lake in Illinois. We are hoping Rend will be a good tournament. If it is other Illinois lakes could be added in the future.

Four 8 hour Saturday sessions: spring - Lake of the Ozarks and Table Rock, fall - Rend and Lake of the Ozarks.

**Mark Twain tournament:** We will be fishing a different area of the lake taking off out of the Spaulding ramp and staying at Country Inn Resort.

**Second annual OPC tournament:** Will be held again this fall at Lake of the Ozarks.

**Special events:** The club barbecue will be held at the Mark Twain tournament, the fish fry will be at the Wappapello tournament and the chili dinner will be the last tournament at Lake of the Ozarks. Other special events are being planned with the help of Terry and Lori Stanek. The information will be sent out when planning is complete.
