

They brought in nine bass for a total weight of 23.49 pounds which is the second highest weight for a club tournament on Wappapello. They caught their fish on crankbaits. The first place payout was \$192. Congratulations Ken and Bob!

Thirteen boats competed in the heat at our Wappapello tournament. Take off was out of Sundowner Marina. Most of our members stayed at Miller's Motor Lodge. Miller's was gracious enough again this year to let us hold our annual fish fry on their grounds. There were 138 bass weighed in and every team had fish. Anglers who pre fished on Friday can tell you that it was unbearably HOT but we had some luck during the tournament hours. Skies were clear to cloudy with some rain on Sunday. We had enough of a breeze to help cool us off with temperatures ranging from the mid 60's to the mid 90's. The lake was close to normal pool. The water was muddy with water temperatures in the high 80's.

Places

Greg Shands and Bryan Slaughter fished their way into second place. Greg and Bryan both had a two day limit (10 fish each), including Bryan's 5.51 big bass of the weekend. The team caught their keepers on crankbaits, spinnerbaits and senkos. Their total weight was 20.47 pounds. Second place payout was \$142.

Mike Parmentier and Sam Sutton took the third place win. They weighed in fourteen fish for a total weight of 16.86 pounds, including Mike's 2.96 big bass for Sunday. Mike was one of four anglers with a two day limit. They were throwing spinnerbaits and wave worms. Third place payout was \$102.

Terry and Lori Stanek took fourth place with sixteen fish weighing a total of 13.87 pounds. They caught their bass on crankbaits and brush hogs. Fourth place payout was \$72.

Big Bass

Big Bass for Saturday and for the weekend was won by Bryan Slaughter. Bryan's bass weighed 5.51 pounds and was caught on a senko. This is Bryan's fourth big bass win this year (LOZ - 6.22, Pomme - 6.00, Mark Twain - 3.91 & Wap - 5.51). Big Bass payout was \$36 and the side pot was \$60.



When And Where

Our next tournament is August 18 - 19 at Lake Pomme de Terre. We will be taking off out of the Pomme State Park Marina. Tournament hours both days are 6:30 am to 12:30 pm. Tournament directors: Saturday - Wakim/T Sullivan, Sunday - Stanek/Stanek.

Directions

To Lake Pomme de Terre:

Take 44 West to exit 129 Lebanon (Hwy 64). Take 64 for 40 miles to 64B. Turn Left on 64B. The Marina is 2 miles on your right.

Reminders

Be sure to get your Pomme entry to Dan by Wednesday, August 15 to avoid a late entry fee.

We still need tournament directors for the Rend and LOZ tournaments. Tournament Directors are awarded three points for serving (one additional point if serving more than one time). We really appreciate members helping out. If you would like to volunteer to be a tournament director please contact any of your officers.

We are now accepting nominations for 2013 officers.
