On Saturday, Tim and John brought an impressive total of 13.16 lbs of fish to the scale topping the next best weight by nearly 7 lbs. It was a very tough day for everyone, but they seemed to find a pattern that worked quite well. Sunday brought another challenge to all but the Dring brothers were able to hold the lead by bringing another two fish in weighing 3.20 lbs and topping all with a total weight of 16.36 lbs and taking first place at our first Rend Lake tournament and paying \$154. Topping this off, Tim brought in the Big Bass for Saturday and the weekend weighing in at 4.76 lb and paying \$30 for the day and \$45 side pot money. The brothers caught all their fish using a shakey head worm.

Rend Lake

We were still able to fish 8 hours, but it was still a battle. Take off was from Gun Creek Ramp and water conditions, although a few inches above normal pool were still very shallow for all. Water temps were in the high 70's and due to a major storm that blew through Friday night, somewhat muddy in some places. On day one, a couple teams had trolling motor problems causing them to drop out on Sunday. We hope they are able to get back on the water soon.

Third place was won by Greg and Andy Shands. They weighed in a total of 5 fish at 10.37 lbs and were caught on chartreuse spinner baits. Third place paid \$84.00.

Rounding out the Fourth place position was Mike Parmentier and Larry Rutledge. They managed to bring in 3 fish totaling 6.00 lbs. Their bait of choice was shakey head, swim baits and brush hogs paying them \$64.
