

In the "News"

WindShield Repair

A mishap at Barkley Lake resulted in a crack in one of the windshields on my Ranger. I contacted Ranger and ordered a new replacement. It arrived in great shape, but there were no holes drilled in it for the mounting screws. I have heard horror stories about drilling into a marine windshield including cracks to completely shattering the windshield due to incorrect drilling methods.

I searched the internet for the "proper way to drill holes in marine windshields". What I found was a contradictory mess that only clouded the issue. "Don't drill too fast", "Don't drill too slow", "Cover both sides with 3 layers of masking tape before you drill", "Just drill the holes", "Use a wood bit", "Use a "Plexiglas" bit", "Use a Step bit". "Keep water flowing on the plastic", "Use oil to lubricate the bit", and on and on. My head was spinning.

On the side of the windshield was a sticker from the original manufacturer, Custom Mold & Tint, who are the original windshield manufacturer for a number of boat brands. I contacted Monica Smith at Custom Mold & Tint to try to get the straight scoop on drilling holes. She was more than willing to help and agreed to provide the correct bit for drilling, however my windshield has 2 different size holes in it.

I continued to stress. Even with the right equipment, lack of experience could end up costing more than it was worth. So, I called Monica again and she agreed to have her folks drill the holes for me. I sent both windshields to her and they drilled the holes in the new one exactly like the old one. I installed the windshield and it looks great.

If you need a replacement windshield or any other plastic product, I recommend you check out Custom Mold & Tint. They are true a pleasure to work with.
