Barkley Lake News

With beautiful weather on Saturday, temps reaching into the high 70s, and Sunday's cloud cover with rain right as weigh in started, fifteen boats battled for the TOP SPOT on Lake Barkley.

Water temps ranged from low to mid 60 degrees and water clarity was stained enough to make it difficult to find any bedding fish. Water levels held tight around 358 ft. Very close to summer pool. We had a slight breeze on Saturday and winds with the pending storm on Sunday.

There were 56 keeper fish weighed in by 23 anglers over a total of 2 days (14 hours). I personally thought we'd find more fish, but I guess the cold winter has pushed the fish a little off schedule. Reports were that everyone was catching fish... just not many keepers.

Overall, I've heard positive feedback on this lake. I for one hope to visit it again and often.

Places...

Greg & Andy Shands took 2nd Place bringing 8 fish to the scale for 17.02 lbs. Each weighed in 4 fish and Greg weighed 1 for BB on Saturday at an impressive 3.23 lbs. All their fish came on Brush Hogs and Lizards. 2nd place payout was \$176.00.

Ken Jones & Mike Jankowski, 3rd place, brought 6 fish to the scale (3 each) weighing a total weight of 14.10 lbs. They caught all their fish on Brush Hogs. 3rd place payout was \$126.00.

4th Place - Dan Durbin & Chris Himstedt brought in a total of 5 fish for a total weight of 10.72 lbs. Dan weighed one on Sunday and Chris weighed 2 each day. They caught their fish on Spinner/ Chatter Bait and Brush Hogs. 4th Place payout was \$86.00.

5th Place - Terry & Lori Stanek were able to weigh in 4 fish (2 each) for a total weight of 9.19 lbs. They report catching all on Brush Hogs and Lizards. 5th place payout was \$124.00.

Winning Strategy - by Brian Forrest

Kentucky lake was recently named in BassMasters Magazine as the 18th best fishery in the nation and when the club decided to go back for a second year, my father and I were extremely excited.

Pre-fishing was a struggle. We hit several spots with little or no luck, but we knew we were onto something because each cove we fished there were 4 to 5 other boats in the area. Some were actual FLW pro's which was really cool to see. We never spoke with other anglers but we did pay close attention to what they were throwing and what colors they were using. At the end of pre fishing we went back to Buzzard rock to fish their cove for fun and that is when my father caught a 6 lb 3 oz slob. Wind was picking up at the time and he decided to throw an old wiggle wart across some chunk rock near the back of the cove which paid off. This gave us some sort of confidence heading into Tournament Day 1. Similar to last year, we thought most fish were going to be shallow. First thing in the morning we caught fish in 1-4 foot of water but they were all short. As the day progressed we caught 1-2 keepers just before 10. We came across our pattern by accident. Because there were several other boats in the area we were often forced to navigate around other boats to fish. During this brief time, we were forced to cast into deeper water 5-10 feet deep and that is when we started to catch more fish and a few keepers.

Because of the bluebird skies, the bite was light and slow. We were forced to slowly drag our jigs or mojo rigs along the bottom floor attempting to slow roll it off chunk rock. We tried crankbaits, swimbaits, spinner baits, football head jigs, brush jigs with chunk trailers and topwaters but plastics and compact jigs turned out to be our best bet. Holding my rod parallel to the water, I either slowly drug my pole left to right or simply slow rolled my reel. When I would pause my retrieve to pick up slack is usually when I received a bite.

Tournament Day 2 was very similar. We started in the same areas of Kentucky but understood that we needed to be fishing 5-8 feet of water. Our boat was positioned between 10-13 foot of water with us casting into 4 to 5 feet. Once again we passed several anglers who were pitching into the shallows or throwing Carolina rigs on secondary points. We stuck to our game and slowly rolled our jig along the bottom, once again we would get hit on the pause. The bite was so soft that we could only tell we had a fish if our lines went to the side or when we picked up a jig we no longer felt rock. We hit several spots on both Kentucky and Barkley and were able to bring in our limit. We caught around 20 fish on Sunday with 16 of them being keepers. Fishing deeper seemed to be the key to our success.

The lure of choice was a 7/16 oz chomper finess jig in green pumpkin or PB & J, with a Berkley critter craw trailer. Our follow up bait or when we had bluebird skies with no wind then we threw a 1/8 oz mojo rig, 4 ot worm hook with a 4 or 5 inch chomper centipede in watermelon seed.
