




BIG BASS (Day)

That's when Dale from Nemo resort came to our rescue, I called him and he drove out to get Bryan and take him back to my truck and trailer. We did fish the area around the ramp we were near, and did manage to catch 4 fish but we were DQed for pulling the boat out of the water. Good news is the new lower unit is sitting over in the shop right now waiting on me to put it on.

Well we are down to only one tournament left. It seems like this year just flew by. It has been an unusual year weather wise with cooler temps thoughout the normally hot months. Our ice cream social was really a bust this time, hard to want ice cream when you got to stand around the bonfire to stay warm. Oh well....a lot of good laughs and stories were had by all.


