12 Fish 30.11 lbs

Tim & John Dring took first place at the Spring Kentucky Lake tournament held out of **Moor's Resort** beating out 22 other boats. They brought 5 fish to the scales on Saturday totaling 13.35 lbs and were able to do even better on Sunday with 7 fish weighing 16.76 lbs. Their combined total of 30.11 pounds put them in first with a cushion of nearly 7 pounds. Their biggest fish was caught by Tim on Saturday weighing 4.25 pounds and was the biggest fish of the day. The Drings reported catching their fish on **Jigs** and **Brush Hogs**. Congratulations to Tim & John! **First Place Payout was \$272**

Lake News

The Big Females were elusive.... While good numbers of fish were caught, the quantity of giants the club hoped to weigh in was lower than expected. Several locals and even pro fishing reports noted that the lake was much tougher to fish this week than normal. Largemouth were in pre-spawn, spawn, and post-spawn patterns and scattered throughout the lake. Like always, the Smallmouth seemed to be further along than the largemouth and were harder to find, although Greg Shands found himself hooking into a nice smallie on Sunday weighing just under 4 pounds. It seems the best working patterns and quality fish were caught off primary and secondary points in slightly deeper water dragging a jig or brush hog.

The water had been steadily rising over the past few weeks as the TVA strategically inched the lake toward summer pool. By the time of tournament blast off, the lake was pretty much there. The legendary submerged "yellow flowers" were visible in many areas of the lake and flooded buck brush was present.


