In 1988, four friends had a vision to form a bass fishing club that provided the friendliest, most affordable and enjoyable bass fishing competition in the St. Louis area. During the first few years, there were only a handful of members and average tournament size was 4 - 6 boats. Monthly "in-person" meetings were held, often at the St. Louis County Library and monthly newsletters were printed on dot-matrix printers and mailed out to members.



Fast forward 30 years and the Hawg Hawlers have become one of the largest and longest running bass fishing clubs in the state of Missouri. 2016 saw 150 active members with average tournament size exceeding 25 boats! Monthly meetings are no longer held and information is distributed via the club's website and social media pages.
