# Lake News

**35 Boats** showed up to start the 2018 year off on the first Lake of Egypt tournament in Hawg Hawler history.

Having only caught 39 fish out of 36 boats the year prior at Clearwater Lake coupled with poor electronic fish sampling numbers from the Missouri Department of Conservation, the club officers figured that a new lake was in order for the first tournament. It is never an easy decision when moving to a new lake for fear of poor turnout, poor fishing and upsetting club members. Lake of Egypt was chosen due to its proximity and because it is a power plant lake that sees warmer weather than most lakes in March. Research indicated good populations of largemouth bass and quality fishing in early March. Fortunately, Lake of Egypt did not disappoint as 35 boats showed up to fish and brought 100 fish to the scales nearly tripling last year's catch. Several members caught quality fish in the slot limit (14-16 inches) which had to be released. The weather was excellent given the time of year and everyone seemed to have a great time.






