Mick & Doris Schwent took 1st place at Table Rock in a large field of 42 boats. This is their second 1st place win at Table Rock and they broke the lake record (previously set by them in 2015) by just 0.07 pounds. They reported catching their fish on ned rigs and tubes which is the same way they secured their win back in 2015.



A huge field of 42 boats showed up to fish Table Rock Lake. 281 fish were brought to the scales over the two day event. **The total combined weight of all the fish exceeded a 1/4 TON!!!** Several Smallmouth, Largemouth, and spotted bass were caught. Amazingly, not very many lunkers were seen with only 2 of the fish weighing in at over 4 pounds. Several anglers reported a strong topwater bite in the morning but you had to be in the right area where the fish were schooling to catch multiple keepers. Quite a few boats reported using ned rigs to catch their keepers.

It was pretty hot on Saturday and there were very few clouds to block the sun from beating down on us. A strong storm rolled in on Sunday and caused several boaters to seek cover. There was heavy wind and downpour that lasted for about 1/2 hour.

A big thanks to **King's Cove Resort** for the breakfast we received Saturday morning and for their hospitality in hosting the club once again.




